

NDG Linux Courses – Cisco NetAcad[™] Exam Activation Documentation

Instructors and Administrators

Network Development Group is offering NDG Linux courses for institutions participating in the Cisco Networking Academy[®] program. In order for learners to take exams in the instructor-led NDG Linux course materials, instructors will first need to activate exams.

NDG Linux courses are typically offered in two versions, *instructor-led* and *self-paced*. Course content is identical between the two, but *self-paced* classes are designed to run without any input from instructors.

Self-paced classes have all exams automatically enabled by default, remove all pre-requisites, and grade students as complete upon finishing the final exam and course feedback.

Instructor-led classes require active involvement from an instructor in order to function correctly. This includes activating exams and manually grading students as complete.

You cannot change exam activation settings in any way for a class that was created as self-paced.

NDG Linux courses are partner courses within the Cisco Network Academy, but hosted externally by NDG. This means that exams are graded and provided externally via NDG tools. The Cisco Networking Academy "Assessment Center" and "VDS Assessment Center" are specifically hidden and disabled in NDG Linux courses. Do not attempt to use these tools when activating NDG Linux exams.

Note: The NDG tools are primarily used to set assessment duration (how long a student will have to finish an exam once it is started) and number of attempts that a student can have to take or retake an exam. While the tool can also be used to restrict access to a limited window of time, this is only recommended if the window is one week or longer. Shorter access windows are difficult to do with the tool and very prone to error, as they almost always require date and time conversions.

In cases where an instructor wishes to restrict student access to exams to a specific time and date window, the Cisco Networking Academy access restrictions built into the LMS are by far more capable and a better choice for doing so. Unlike the NetAcad itself and the NetAcad LMS, all dates and times found in the NDG tools are expressed in UTC and not your locally selected time zone. Activation windows or advanced activations require the manual conversion of date and time from UTC to your local time.



Create and Apply a Default Exam Activation

1. Open the *Help & Resources* Module. All instructor materials for the NDG Linux courses are contained within the *Help & Resources* module.

2. Click Assessment Tool under the Resources heading.

3. Click Create Activation Profile.

These will be the default profile, but can be overridden or not applied to all exams if desired. For example, you may wish your students to have additional time for mid-term or final exams.

8. Exams now show a check for Current Activations.

Any exam that shows a current activation is open to students (unless otherwise restricted by assignment settings in the NetAcad LMS). If there is no check in current activation or only a check in expired activations, the exam will not be accessible. Note that you can have a check in both columns (both current and expired), but this does indicate an active exam.



Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I change exam activations after they are entered?

Once an activation is applied to an assessment, it cannot be modified or deleted. If you wish to modify the activation, it is then recommended to create a new activation with a start date starting on the same date or on a later date (within the time period of the last activation) as the previous activation. This will enable the new activation to overwrite the previous one. If this modification will not work in your situation and you wish to enable the activation at a much later date that does not fit within the previous activation's time block, then contact NDG support team to manually remove the desired activations. See example below.
